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DTOWN SHOWSOWN RULES AND GUIDELINES

General Competition Information

The **Competition** will be held at Dallastown High School located at 700 New School Lane, Dallastown, PA 17313.

Event organizers reserve the right to create multiple sessions in order to limit the number of spectators and athletes in the building. Session start times will depend on the number of registered teams. All cheer teams will compete on a 54' x 42' floor (9 panels). All participants must be current members of the 2024 - 2025 teams.

Payment and Fees

General admission fees: Adults \$10; Students \$5; Pre-K and younger FREE

Safety and Liability

The Dtown Showdown DOES require individual medical release forms for cheerleaders.

Medical personnel will be on-site for medical emergencies (not taping) the entire day.

Absolutely NO JEWELRY; 5-point deduction per occurrence. Teams are encouraged to perform skills within their ability level. DTOWN Showdown officials and Dallastown Area School District officials are not responsible for injury to participants. Participants assume all risk and responsibility.

DTOWN Showdown officials and Dallastown Area School District officials are not responsible for personal items that may be lost or stolen.

Order of Performance

Officials of the Dtown Showdown will determine the order of competition.

Order of performance and warm-up times will be emailed to coaches with participating teams on the **Wednesday** prior to the event. If your teams need any special considerations for performance times, etc. please note it CLEARLY on the registration form.

Rec teams typically compete in the morning. High school teams typically compete in the afternoon. If necessary, Varsity teams that are participating in the Game Day division may compete in the morning in addition to competing in the afternoon.

Music

Coaches will be expected to start and stop their own music or provide someone from your organization to play the music.

Music is expected to be in good taste with no questionable language. The DJ has the capability to play routine music from a phone. Coaches must assume all responsibility for putting the phone in airplane mode and any other settings to ensure no interruptions in music.

Competition Divisions

For school teams, divisions are determined by the grade level of the oldest participant at the time of the competition. For rec teams, divisions are determined by the

cheerleader's age as of Aug 31, 2024.

In the event that participation in a division does not promote a quality competition, the event organizers reserve the right to combine

divisions of like ages or levels without prior notice.

Event organizers also reserve the right to split a division into "Small" or "Large" for example if there will be at least two teams in the division. PIAA Team Sizes: Small teams= up to 15 members; Large teams= 16 and above.

Time Limits and Routine Structure

Timing will begin with the first official movement, voices in unison, or the first sound of music.

Total routine length is limited to 2:30 minutes for traditional routine and 3 minutes for Game Day routine.

Total performance time may constitute all music for the rec, school, or any combination thereof.

Prior to the start of a routine, all participants must be positioned inside the boundary lines and must be supporting their own weight on the floor.

If a routine is interrupted by equipment failure, the team will be permitted to pick up their routine from the point in which the disruption

occurred.

In case of injury, the team may continue with the routine, come off and re-group, or withdraw from the competition. The Dtown Showdown officials reserve the right to halt a routine in the case of an injury. Game Day routines (no running tumbling, no tosses, no inversions, no twisting released dismounts) will consist of: 1. Band Dance (no skills other than kicks and jumps) 2. Offense or Defense Situational Sideline (with props and practical skills) 3. Cheer 4. Fight Song

Scoring

The 2024-25 NFHS/USA Cheer rules will govern the school team divisions as they appear in the 2024-25 NFHS Spirit Rules Book. All-star and open teams will follow 2024-25 USASF rules as presented to members by USASF.

The scores of the judges will be added to form a subtotal. There is no penalty for stepping out of bounds. However, any element such as a tumbling pass, a basket toss, or pyramid/partner stunt that occurs or lands out of bounds (marked by white lines) will be assessed a 5-point deduction.

Deductions for jewelry, time violations, safety guideline violations, or inappropriate choreography will be subtracted from the subtotal to acquire the final score. The emphasis is on a clean routine.

Deductions/penalties are assessed at the sole discretion of the judges. All judges' decisions are final. Ties will not be broken. Teams that place in a tie will both receive awards.

Sample score sheets will be emailed upon request to coaches of participating teams.

Awards and Judging

Awards will be determined by the number of teams in each division Judges will be qualified, impartial individuals representing various styles of cheerleading.

Decisions made by the judging panel are final. Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES is a coach, parent, participant, or fan permitted to question or approach a judge on score sheet decisions.
